1. HEALTH HAZARD INFORMATION

Effects of Osmium is considered poisonous and should be handled with caution. Effects include ocular

exposure disturbances, respiratory difficulties, heavy metal poisoning.

ACUTEEFFECTS:

Inhalation Irritating to mucous membranes and upper respiratory tract. May cause asthmatic condition, bronchitis.

Ingestion May cause gastrointestinal irritation. No other effects known.

Skin Causes irritation, dermatitis, ulceration of the skin.

Eye Causes severe eye irritation, ocular disturbances, conjunctivitis. May cause blindness.

CHRONIC EFFECTS:

 Inhalation
 Bronchitis.

 Not known.

 Dematitis.

Eye May cause blindness.

OTHER HEALTH HAZARDS:

Adverse health effects are due mainly to OsO4.

- Very hard, and very conductive


